Course Goal

The goal of this course is to improve outcomes for adult patients with cardiac arrest and other cardiopulmonary emergencies through provider training.

Objectives

Successful Participants will be able to:

- ❑ Recognize and initiate early management of peri-arrest conditions that may result in cardiac arrest or complicate resuscitation outcome
- ❑ Demonstrate proficiency in providing BLS care, including prioritizing chest compressions and integrating use of an AED
- ❑ Recognize and manage respiratory arrest; cardiac arrest until termination of resuscitation or transfer of care, including immediate post-cardiac arrest care
- ❑ Recognize and initiate early management of acute coronary syndromes (ACS) and stroke, including appropriate disposition
- ❑ Demonstrate effective communication as a member or leader of a resuscitation team and recognize the impact of team dynamics on overall team performance
