Purpose of this Study

Researchers are trying to collect blood samples to study (analyze) from patients that are scheduled to undergo a low dose CT scan (LDCT) procedure. Researchers will use the blood samples to try to develop new drugs, treatments or tests, and study how individual differences may affect how drugs work.

Who can Participate?

- Patient must be ≥ 18 years of age at the time of blood collection.
- Patients must be scheduled to undergo a low dose CT (LDCT) scan for lung cancer screening, surveillance, or diagnosis.
- No history of cancer, except for non-melanoma skin cancer and in-situ carcinomas.

Requirements

- Willing to complete a consent and a one time in-person visit with research staff.
- Collection of 4 tablespoons of blood at time of visit. (Blood must be drawn 60 days prior, on the day of or up to 10 days after the LDCT.)
- Collection of Personal Health Information (PHI) including medical history, medications, lifestyle habits and family history.
